Some years are approximate; those are indicated by the abbreviation “ca.” which means circa or around. Most years listed are inclusive, but others are incomplete. In some cases, the language of the records (other than English) and whether the records contain an index is also noted.

Reel information: Prefixes and numbers that appear in parentheses after the description of the content of the microfilm. Refers to actual reels of microfilm in the Library.
